Working in partnership

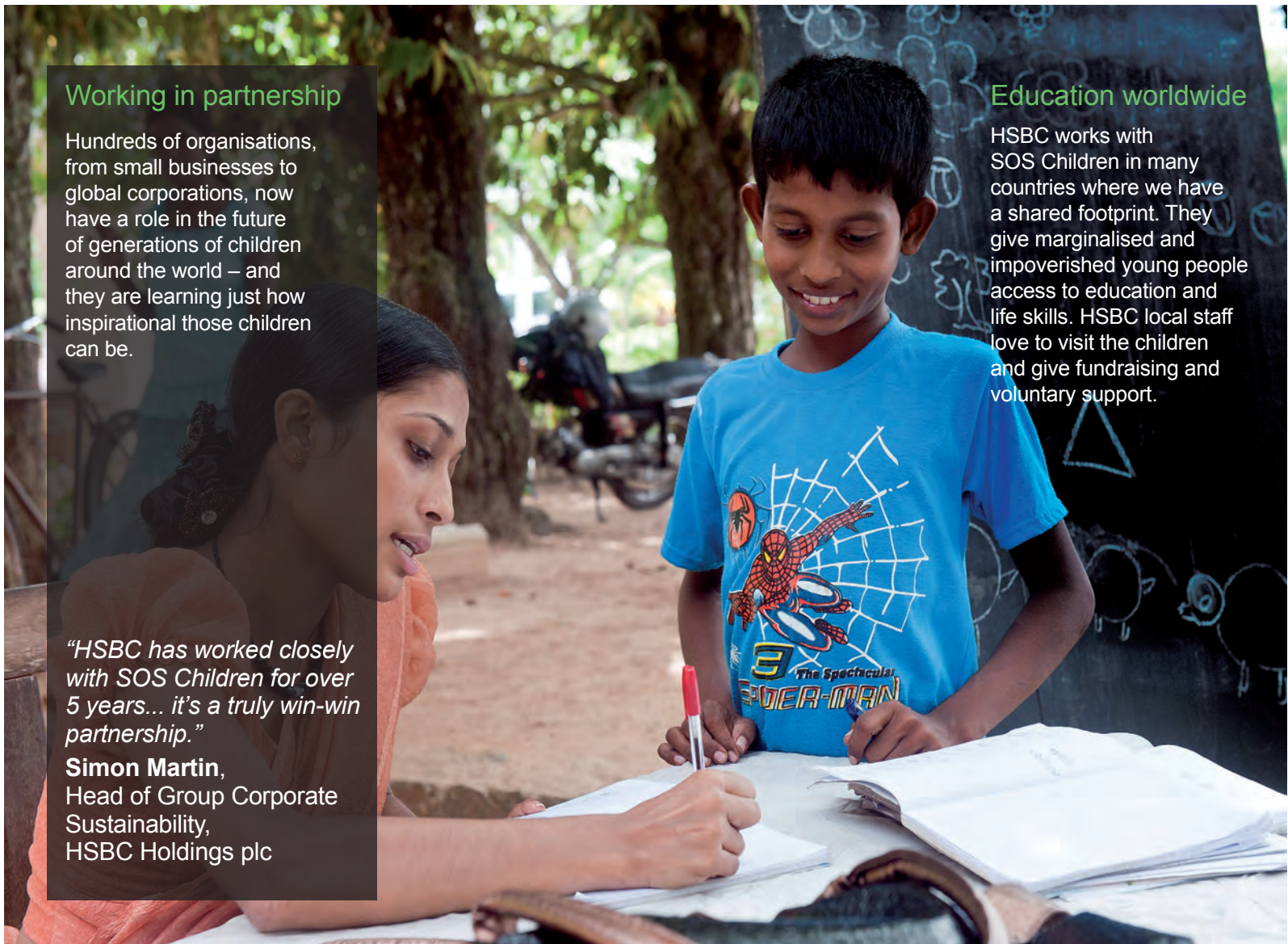
Hundreds of organisations, from small businesses to global corporations, now have a role in the future of generations of children around the world – and they are learning just how inspirational those children can be.
